In 1993, recognizing that the escalating crisis facing all five rhino species was not receiving the attention it deserved, the International Black Rhino Foundation expanded its mission and became the International Rhino Foundation (IRF). For the last 20 years, IRF has funded and operated rhino conservation programs in Africa and Asia, focusing expertise and resources in areas where rhinos are most in need of protection, and where conservation efforts will have the most significant impact.

Since its founding, IRF has provided funding for scientific research that enhances the ability to manage rhinoceros populations both in the wild and in captivity. IRF also works with conservation centers and zoos to provide linkages between captive and wild populations of rhinos. At the heart of IRF's vision is the belief that these magnificent species should endure for future generations, and that protecting rhinos ensures the survival of many other species that share their habitat, including people.

#### Summary of 2013 Programs and Projects:

Zimbabwe Black Rhino Conservation – The IRF-supported Lowveld Rhino Trust (LRT) manages rhino monitoring and anti-poaching units in Zimbabwe. The Lowveld Conservancies now hold nearly 90 percent of Zimbabwe's black rhinos. In 2013, LRT staff conducted a total of 41 black rhino immobilizations in Zimbabwe's Bubye Valley and Save Valley Conservancies, without any procedure-related complications or mortality. Included in these ongoing management activities were immobilizations were 35 ear-notchings, three de-hornings, two transmitter implants, and two veterinary treatments of wounds suffered due to poaching attempts. The total detected rhino deaths for the year stands at five black rhinos; four in Bubye Valley and one in Save Valley. Poaching losses in the Save Valley Conservancy were linked to unplanned settlement within its former perimeter. One natural mortality (a black rhino calf probably killed by hyenas) was reported in Save Valley. On the positive side, monitoring teams tallied 17 black rhino births in Save Valley and 18 in the Bubye Valley Conservancy.

Southern Africa, Operation Stop Poaching Now — Rhino poaching in South Africa reached an all-time high in 2013, with 1,004 rhino lost. The aims of Operation Stop Poaching Now are to conduct security needs assessments in selected areas, provide equipment and training that would allow anti-poaching staff in those areas to meet minimum security standards as prescribed by the South African Development Community Rhino Management Group, and to provide equipment

and training to aid rhino crime scene investigations so that solid, admissible evidence against poaching suspects can be generated.

In 2012, IRF launched a new project with partners in Zimbabwe and South Africa to adequately equip and train rhino protection staff in a number of protected areas. Security experts conducted needs assessments in Zimbabwe's Save Valley Conservancy, Malilangwe Reserve, Bubye Valley, Gonarezhou National Park, Matobos National Park and Sinamatella conservation areas, and in South Africa's Double Drift Nature Reserve (Eastern Cape) and Loskop Nature Reserve (Mpumulanga). The selection of target conservation areas was carried out in conjunction with the Southern African Development Community (SADC) Rhino Management Group and relevant rhino management authorities. This project was continued in 2013 in South Africa, with two courses provided at the Weltrac Training Center in the Waterberg for participants from South Africa's North West, Kwazulu Natal, Limpopo, and Mpumalanga provinces, as well as for a participant from Zambia.

Sixteen candidates from three provinces (Eastern Cape, North West and Limpopo) attended two 21-day advanced field ranger training at the Weltrac Training Center in Waterberg, South Africa. In Zimbabwe, 50 antipoaching staff from Matobo National Park, Sinamatella (Intensive Protection Zone) in Hwange National Park, Save Valley Conservancy and Bubye Valley, attended two additional 21-day courses. The program included modules on human tracking/anti-tracking, animal tracking, camouflage, patrols and formations, discipline and drills, firearms safety, first aid, communication and planning, among other topics.

The last course held in 2013 took place from 10-24 October at the Weltrac Training Centre on Welgevonden Game Reserve. Participants had a wide range of experience in conservation and came from various provinces in South Africa including Limpopo, Northern Cape, Gauteng, Eastern Cape and North West. Reserves represented were: Marakele National Park, Addo Elephant National Park, Dinokeng, Lapalala Welgevonden, Sable Ranch and Wintershoek.

As part of Operation Stop Poaching Now, IRF commissioned the development of an antipoaching dog trial in Zimbabwe. The olfactory capabilities of dogs make them an effective antipoaching tool that can be deployed in conservation areas where they are trained to track people,
as well as to find arms and ammunition; poachers often stash weapons in the bush to reduce the
risk of their being caught with weapons. The dogs also can cover large distances, can track at
night (when most poaching incidents occur) and can be trained to attack on. Through the
Operation Stop Poaching Now campaign, we provided a grant to the Endangered Wildlife Trust
(EWT) to train dogs that can be used to track poachers and rhinos calves orphaned after a
poaching incident. Three dogs – a bloodhound, a Belgian shepherd, and a hybrid – were first
evaluated for suitable temperament and physical capacity in South Africa by EWT and Green
Dogs for Conservation. They were then trialed in Zimbabwe but for a variety of reasons,
including the heat and distances traveled, did not perform as expected.

In southwestern South Africa, IRF is supporting the Munawana Conservation Fund, affiliated with the Phinda Private Game Reserve in KwaZulu Natal (KZN) province. Although rhino poaching is widespread across South Africa, with both state and privately owned rhinos being targeted, the conservation areas with the most significant populations, such as Phinda, are the

main focus of attention. It is clear is that greater and more focused interventions that adapt to the current situations need to be implemented. Such interventions need to be original and creative in order to be effective.

Recent successes in KZN have shown the critical value of rewarding informants for information. The amounts having to be paid to reward people for information leading to a positive/confirmed crime relating to rhino poaching has also seen a dramatic increase, but can be a costly exercise for reserves and private security companies. Recent experience and success have shown that rewarding for information for an incident and not waiting for a conviction, which could take years to finalize, has an immediate positive impact on the fight against rhino related and other wildlife crimes. We have therefore provided Munawana Conservation Fund with a seed-grant to help them implement an informant reward system, and will be meeting with them in March 2014. Further funding will depend on the grantee's performance.

India Rhino Conservation – IRF provided support for implementing *Indian Rhino Vision 2020*, a collaborative effort among the government of Assam (India), WWF -India, the Bodo Territorial Council, and IRF with the goal of increasing the population of Indian rhinos to 3,000 by the year 2020 and translocating animals in order spread the population out more evenly over at least seven national parks. From 2008-2013, a total of 18 animals were translocated from Pabitora Wildlife Sanctuary and Kaziranga National Park to Manas National Park as part of the program; and another group moved additional seven animals. Five animals were poached in 2013, bringing to seven the number lost to poachers since reintroduction efforts began in 2008. However, 10 rhino calves have been born in Manas under the auspices of Indian Rhino Vision 2020, nine of these births occurred in 2013. Two of the poaching losses were mothers with calves; those animals are now being hand-reared. Due to the increased poaching activity in 2013, no additional rhino translocations to Manas National Park are planned until protection can be enhanced. A new security assessment has been undertaken and the issue is being addressed on a number of levels, including training programs for park guards and working with local villages to ensure stakeholder support for rhino protection efforts.

Indonesian Rhino Conservation – IRF supports three major rhino conservation initiatives: *Rhino Protection Units* (RPUs) rigorously patrol forests to destroy snares and traps (the main made of poaching for these species) and apprehend poachers. By gathering intelligence from local communities, RPUs also proactively prevent poaching attempts before they take place. RPUs have been very effective in protecting the rhino from poachers - only five Sumatran rhinos have been lost to poachers since the inception of the program, and no Javan rhinos have been killed. By virtue of the RPUs' consistent presence and patrolling, other species, such as Sumatran tigers and elephants also benefit, as does the ecosystem as a whole. Seven patrol units operate in Bukit Barisan Selatan National Park in Sumatra, one of the highest priority areas for Sumatran megafauna. Approximately 40-60 Sumatran rhino (the second largest population in the world) inhabit the Park, along with 40-50 Sumatran tigers and around 500 Asian elephants. Five patrol units operate in Way Kambas National Park, which has a resident population of nearly 35 Sumatran rhino (the third largest population of Sumatran rhinos) and is also the site of the Sumatran Rhino Sanctuary. Four RPUs protect Javan rhinos in Ujung Kulon National Park, where the only viable population of the species exists (estimated between 35 and 44 animals).

The Sumatran Rhino Sanctuary (SRS), built and funded by the IRF, encompasses 100 hectares (247 acres) for propagation, research and education. The SRS received its first rhino in 1998. The SRS is now home to five animals and is staffed by two full-time Indonesian veterinarians, ten keepers, and several administrative and support staff. Over the years, a number of circumstantial, medical, and management problems have been addressed and overcome and within the last decade, the husbandry and captive propagation of Sumatran rhinos has matured. The IRF has been steadfastly working to address these issues with the expertise of numerous veterinarians and reproductive biologists from the US, Australia, and Indonesia. This work has paid off – on June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012, the Sanctuary's first calf, "Andatu" was born.

Javan Rhino Conservation - Ujung Kulon National Park is home to the only remaining viable population of Javan rhinos in the world – no more than 50 estimated animals. IRF works closely with Yayasan Badak Indonesia (YABI), its implementing partner in Indonesia, the Ujung Kulon National Park authorities, WWF-Indonesia and the local, provincial, and national government towards the species' conservation. In 2010, IRF and partners launched the Javan Rhino Study and Conservation Area (JRSCA) within Ujung Kulon National Park (UK) with the idea that improving the habitat in the Gunung Honje area (the eastern part of the park) will draw more rhinos and thus enable the population to expand. Work is continuing to construct an electric fence and adjacent patrol road, small bridges, and to implement habitat management activities such as clearing of the invasive Arenga palm and providing for a water supply and saltlick, construct new guard posts, and socializing the project with local communities. Fifty plots have been cleared of Arenga palm so far, which has resulted in nine rhinos moving into the. The JRSCA is a study and conservation area to enable learning more about the population. It also should lead to an increase in the number of rhinos, which would eventually allow translocating a subset of the Ujung Kulon animals to a suitable second site, still to be identified, as an 'insurance' population. The JRSCA will be completed in 2014.

**Technical Assistance** – IRF provided funding to other rhino-focused groups, including support for the Chairman and Scientific Officer of the IUCN/SSC African Rhino Specialist Group, Chairman of the IUCN/SSC Asian Rhino Specialist Group, the IRF Indonesia Liaison position, the Rhino Resource Center (a central repository for rhino information), and funding for a Large Mammal Conservationist for the Wildlife and Areas Welfare Trust in India.

Research – In 2009, as part of its commitment to rhino conservation research, IRF issued a request for pre-proposals, and invited 11 of the 30 pre-proposals received to submit a full proposal for funding consideration. Pre-proposals and proposals were reviewed by independent outside researchers and five were selected for grant awards, with a total of \$240,325 awarded. The projects were: (1) Radio frequency identification system for monitoring wild rhino populations (\$25,000); (2) Pan-African physiogeography and evolutionary history of the black rhinoceros (\$53,945); (3) Population genetic monitoring of Indian rhino in Assam: an evaluation of genetic diversity and population differentiation through non-invasive sampling (\$55,100); (4) Effects of acid-base, electrolyte, energy and cardiorespiratory imbalances during capture and confinement on boma adaptation in white rhinos (\$36,280); and (5) Genetic estimates of Javan and Sumatran rhino population size and sex radio using fecal samples - building on recent progress (\$70,000). All but Project 1 have been completed and final reports submitted. Project 1 was given a no-cost extension in January 2013 because of RFID tag supplier difficulties, with a

new expected completion date of 1 February 2015. A new request for proposals will be sent out in 2014.
